Three Pillars of Our Work

1. AI-Enabled Educator & Student Empowerment	We are on a mission to empower 100 higher education institutions across Karnataka , with a special focus on Government First Grade Colleges , through impactful CSR initiatives. Our programmes focus on AI-enabled education, faculty capacity building, personalised learning, student skill development, mental health and well-being, ethics, leadership, and soft skills . We have already signed MoUs with six esteemed Government First Grade Colleges in and around Bengaluru , establishing a strong foundation to scale this initiative across Karnataka and create a future-ready, inclusive, and empowered higher education ecosystem.
2. Global Classrooms	Connecting rural schools, teachers and students to global experts via ICT & AI — technology integration, teacher empowerment, and international exposure.
3. Rural Empowerment & Well-Being	Health camps, self-help skilling (tailoring, crafts, small enterprise), judgment-free mental-health counselling, and community sanitation & nutrition drives for women and girls.

Global Classrooms — Our Track Record

Our flagship Global Classroom initiative — envisioned to eventually connect 100,000 schools across India — has, to date, conducted 21 Global Classroom activities in rural schools across Sutarwadi, Lawale, Jambe and other Zilla Parishad Primary Schools in Mulshi Taluka; delivered Teacher Empowerment & Capacity Building programs to 20+ schools in Pune and Thane, as well as D Y Patil Engineering College and Suryadatta Institute; and presented our Girls' Empowerment & English Communication Lab at BMC Mumbai and ZP/BMC schools in Thane district. We have signed an MOU with BMC Schools for video-conferencing-based sessions, connected India-based experts working in Germany to rural classrooms, and opened smart-village discussions with Panchayat Samiti Mulshi. This work was recognised at Huddle 2018 in Kerala, where our Global Classroom concept was ranked among India's top innovative edtech initiatives, and has since been featured on YourStory.com and Pune365.com.

Self-Help, Mental Health and Rural Empowerment

Alongside our education work, NWLF's Rural Empowerment & Well-Being program— has reached over 10,000 women and girls across 50+ villages through four pillars: free health camps and maternal-care awareness drives; self-help skill workshops in tailoring, crafts and small enterprise to build economic independence; safe, judgment-free counselling support for emotional and mental well-being; and community sanitation, nutrition and awareness drives. Our Girls & Women Empowerment through Entrepreneurial Education programme equips rural women to start and manage their own micro-enterprises, while our Adult Education initiative strengthens behavioural, health and hygiene practices for sustainable community development. **Thank You,**
